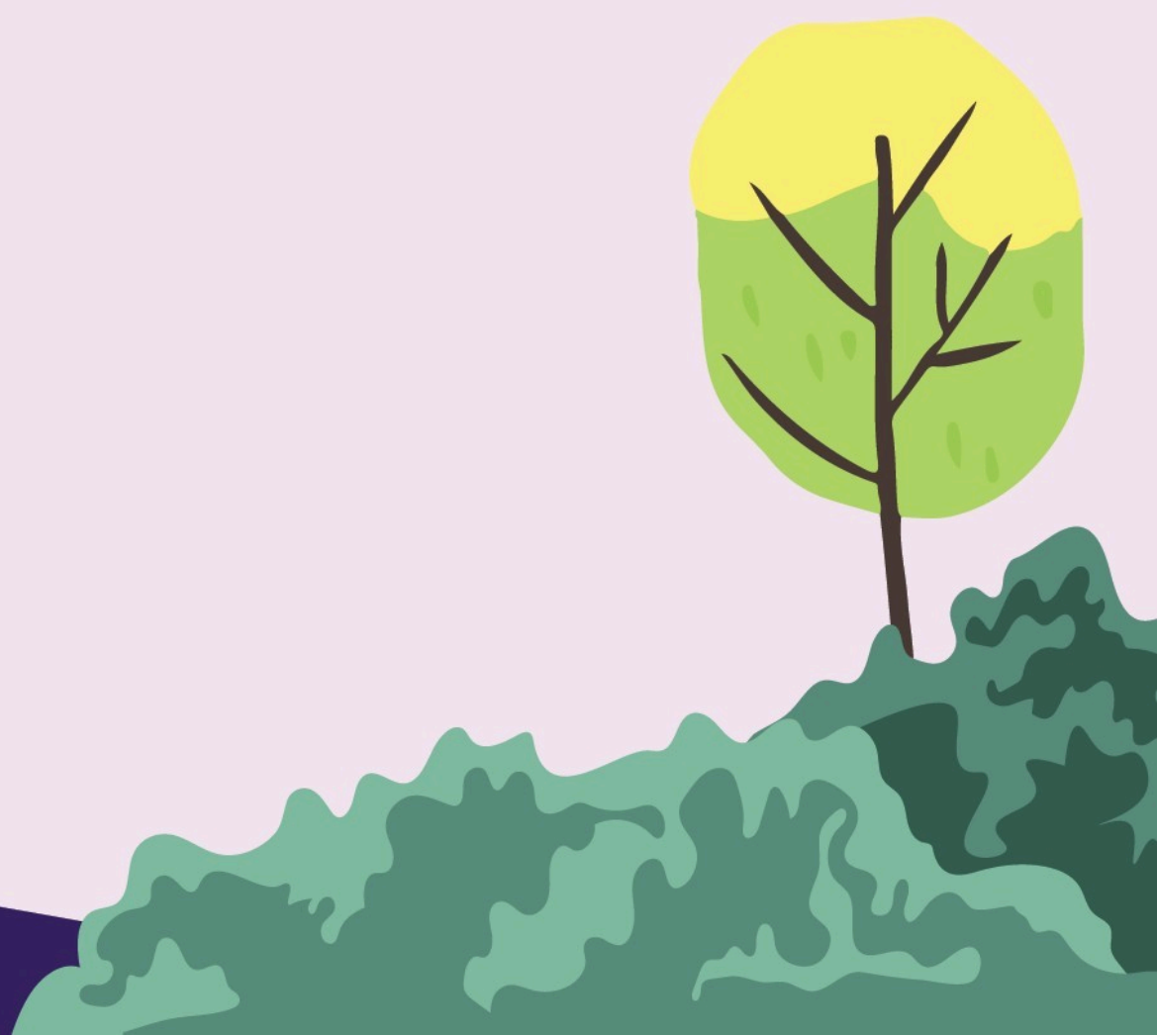

As we prepare for Lent, Holy Week and Easter, there are a number of opportunities available for prayer, reflection and worship. All are warmly welcome. This year the Church of England's Lent theme is Draw Near: Life-giving habits for Lent

“Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.” (James 4.8)

This theme invites us to develop a rhythm of life — habits of prayer and discipleship that draw us closer to God as we prepare for Easter.

Ash Wednesday, 18 February
